A P R O C L A M A T I O N.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of the State aforesaid, made and passed at their Session holden at *Providence*, on the last *Monday* of *January*, in the present Year, entitled, “*An Act establishing the Digest of Laws, as reported by the Committee appointed to revise the Laws of this State, and amended by the General Assembly, at the last and present Session,*” it is among other Things enacted, that within One Month after the said Laws shall have been printed and distributed, as therein provided, the Governor of the said State be authorized and requested to issue a Proclamation, announcing that the Laws contained in said Digest shall be in full Force and Effect, immediately after the Expiration of Thirty Days from the Date of said Proclamation: And whereas the said Laws have been printed by *Carter and Wilkinson*, at *Providence*, in an Octavo Volume, under the Title of “*The public Laws of the State of Rhode-Island and Providence Plantations, as revised by a Committee, and finally enacted by the Honourable General Assembly, at their Session in January, 1798,*” and duly distributed: I DO THEREFORE issue this Proclamation, to make known that the Laws contained in the said Digest will be in full Force and Effect immediately after the Expiration of Thirty Days from the Date hereof; of which all Persons concerned are to take due Notice, and govern themselves accordingly.
